Through this programme organization has formed 210 vigilance groups having 15 members each group for the prevention of human trafficking, organization has rescued 47 girls from the brothel and other places with the help of Police and vigilance groups, After counselling of survivors they re-settled down in their homes, Project staffs regular touch with Survivors and proper counselling give them new ideas for the change of life style .

Report COVID 19 RAHAT I PARTNER.2020.

As we aware that CORONA VIRUS (COVID 19) are spreading all over the world and people are also suffering from it. Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi Govt has strictly announced that all people of India stay at home and safe your life under LOCK DOWN .Here our organization has been working on awareness activities among the people for hygiene and sanitation also share with them through pictorial and text message and announcing about precaution of Corona virus. during this job we have observed many people has no any food ,they are wavering and willing to get such kind of food for relief.

so that we have identified 500 families are totally in deprived and need to distribute dry food items among them. organization has decided to work on distribution of dry food items among the families who are totally deprived and seeking food and directly communicated with I PARTNER INDIA who accepted our proposal and ready to support for distribution of Ration among the vulnerable and marginalized families also widow, handicapped and others.

The COVID 19 pandemic has paralyzed the whole country by creating devastating social, political and economic crisis. The deep scars of its outbreak could be seen on the lives of marginalized and vulnerable sections of the society as their survival has come to a standstill. Many have already lost their work and are still continuing their struggle to rebuild their livelihood as this loss of income is proving to be catastrophic on several fronts. RAHAT and I PARTNER INDIA has always been in a forefront to respond to disaster or crisis. During the hour of struggle to survive by many categories in society ,RAHAT is working rigorously by spreading its helping hand to the needy and marginalized people by being operation in kishanganj district of Bihar by the supporting of I PARTNER INDIA with 500 families.

Due to lockdown though people are not allowed to trespass and commute anywhere because of continuous strict monitoring by police officers and the shutdown of entry and exit route of every villages, our volunteers and staffs are taking huge risk and effort in initiating the activities initiated by RAHAT.

Awareness was disseminated through the miking of regular hand wash for 20 seconds, importance of wearing Mask, maintaining health and hygiene and social distancing etc. Community was also informed that people entering the village due to reverse migration should be asked to undergo check-up first before entering the village or locality. They must immediately by taking a person to the hospital showing any symtoms of COVID 19.

Procedure of selection of Beneficiaries :

- Organization has formed Disaster Team who will be done in any disaster with the help of Community they have selected the needy people from the society.
- Volunteers of the organization-RAHAT has visited and surveyed with the disaster team to the village and identified the beneficiaries who are widow, single women, physical challenged for the purpose of distribution of Dry Ration and hygiene kit, Sanitizer and Mask.

- Finally disaster team and Organization level team has selected 500 beneficiaries for distribution of Food and non food items among the beneficiaries.
- Lastly volunteers has captured the family photographs of the beneficiaries for proving their identity accordingly.

Distribution Process :

RAHAT has shared all information with District Administration and police officials for the distribution of Ration in identified areas and SDM(Sub Divisional magistrate) and ASDM(Additional Sub Divisional Magistrate) has distributed food and non –food items to the beneficiaries in different areas.

Organization has conducted many activities like

Organization has reached 200 families and 5000 people through these group members.
- **Formation of Vigilance Committee at Village level** : 15-20 people of each group who are responsible person for Prevention of human Trafficking and how to rescue and rehabilitation of survivors if any occurrence.10 vigilance committee has been formed for the purpose of Prevent Child Trafficking,Childmarriage,Fake marriage through the community and PRI's members
- **Help Desk : Establishment of support Centre for counseling and awareness programme also sharing all information in regards to Human Trafficking, Child protection and IEC Materials-**
- Panchayat and Block level Capacity Building and Strengthening of Newly elected Panchayati Raj Members for childTrafficking and child marriage: Organization has organized a meeting with different stakeholders at different level like Panchayat, Block and District level on prevention of child trafficking through the community and stakeholders, Organization has reached 1500 people directly and 7500 people indirectly through this activities.

- ❖ Youth and Vigilance group members were working on prevention of child trafficking and child marriage,they are sharing such kind of issues at religious seminar and local functions organized by the Panchayat.

Help Desk is one of the key centre for counselling of survivors who are suffering from various social issues like domestic violence,Gender Discrimination,Abuse.3159 women.

In this workshop ADJ was chief guest and other Judiciaries department also present and also all Police dept like SDPO along with Police team belongs to all Thana's and all Advocates especially who are involving in VAW case. organizations are continuously working and maintained coordination with Govt. dept for the implementation of such act .27856 women directly connected to this programme and 23745 men also .all of them are aware and sensitized on violence against women and reduced domestic violence case from intervention areas. this is good achievement .

Mahila and Yuvadastak members has trained on prevention of Domestic violence and how to resolve the such type of case within the societies and solved it in Village level. Rahat organization has been working on Prevention of Human Trafficking through community Mobilization and livelihood promotion at Sukhsaina Panchayat of Palasi Block of Araria District of Bihar for last four years. In this project main objective is basic knowledge sharing with the community for the eradication of Human Trafficking from the society and how to develop their livelihood and benefit from the government department.

Organization has formed Community Based organization for the purpose of elimination of Child trafficking, child marriage, Dowry. Also insisted the community leaders for the motivation and support to Survivors who are economically very weak from the Govt schemes.

Apart from that 35 identified survivors has taken training on Tailoring for their livelihood promotion and sold dependent. 2234 people has directly benefited from PDS card, MNREGA – job card 727 drop out children has re admitted in govt. schools.

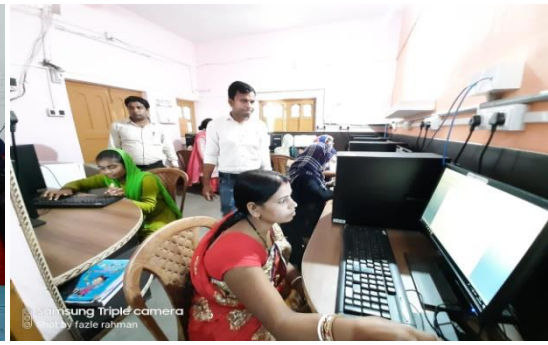
Vocational Training Prog:
