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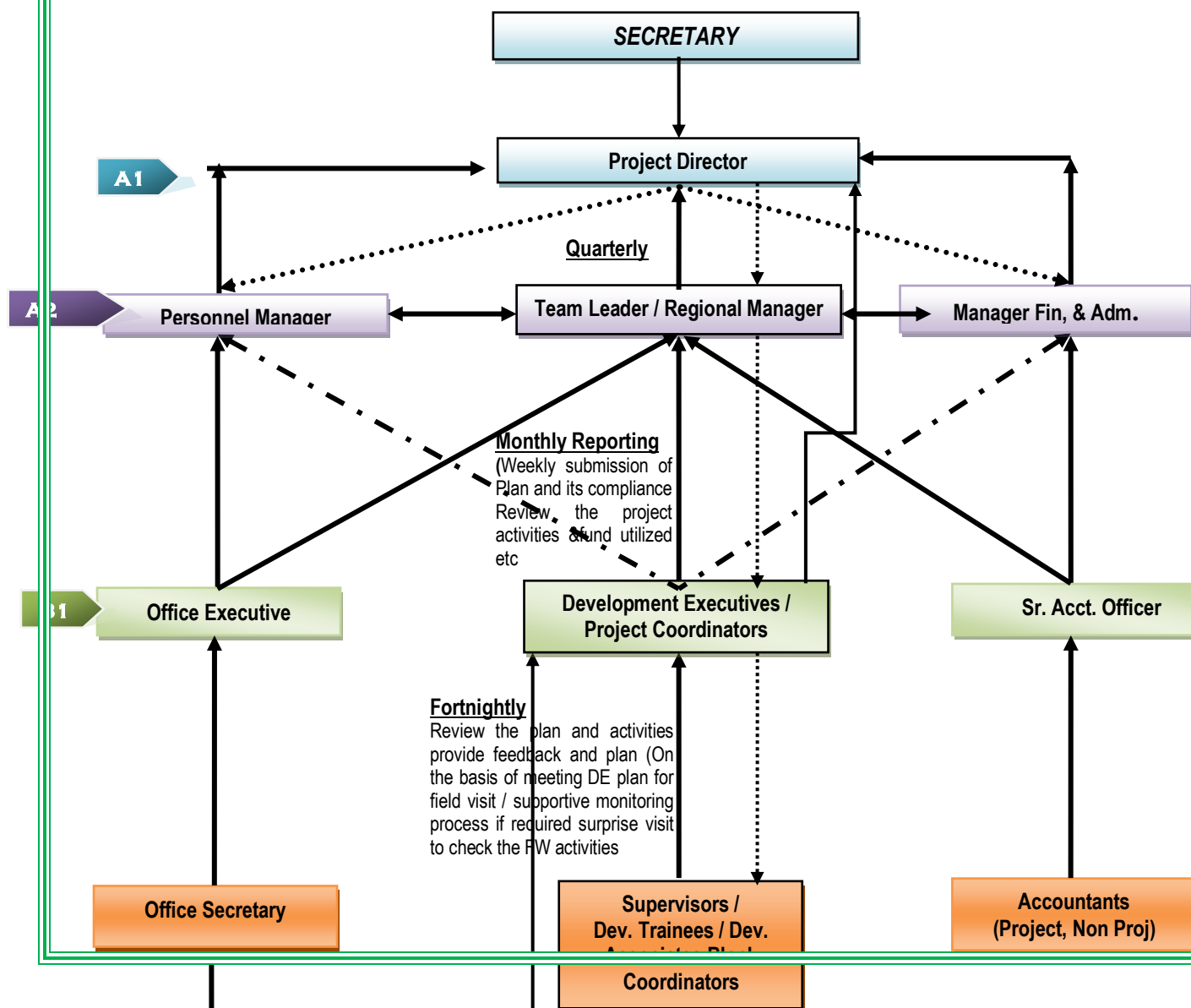

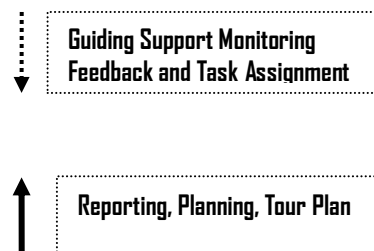

After completion of apprenticeship of 5 years as volunteers She has decided to register an organization to do the work of in more organized way. RAHAT has been registered under legally under FCRA and is quite active in the field of Rural Development since 2002 in all districts of Bihar. The organization focusing on major issues like education, Health, domestic violence, Human Trafficking, social reform, Training, Livelihood promotion, Disaster, rights and capacity building and sustainable on-farm and non-farm agro based income generation activities through the promotion of SHGs/CBO and right based approach. It is a unit within the system of the government (Dept. of Social Welfare), And District Administration Kishanganj, which is committed to respond to the critical needs of the victims of violence. Counselling services if needed are provided, by trained counsellors. If legal assistance is necessary the same is provided through Legal Services authority or through the legal aid committee functioning under the chairmanship of a District magistrate. HELPLINE was established in Kishanganj in September 2007 through RAHAT NGO as a crisis intervention centre for women in distress. Every district of Bihar shall have one Helpline.
11	Short Stay Home (WDC)	Rahat Established Short stay home in 2009 with the support of District Administration and WDC patna at Kishanganj, aims at providing temporary 25 bedded shelter and support to women and girls, who have no social support systems to rely on and also to rehabilitate women and girls socially and economically by provision of skill training and counselling. Short Stay Home run under the Guidance of RAHAT, Kishanganj.
